The purpose of this letter is to promote co-operation in the field of teaching and research between department of tourism management of the University of Mazandaran and department of geography of the Justus Liebig University of Giessen.

Both institutions will make every reasonable effort to encourage direct contact and research institutes. Both departments agree to enter into negotiations on the following general forms of co-operation.

- (i) Joint research activities,
- (ii) Exchange of academic materials and academic publications and information,
- (iii) Exchange of staff members for research, lectures and discussions,
- (iv) Exchange of graduate and undergraduate students for study and research,
- (v) Co-organization and participation in lectures, seminars and conferences.

The themes of joint activities, the conditions for utilizing the results achieved and the arrangements for specific visits, exchanges and other forms of co-operation will be negotiated separately for each specific case by the interested parties.

It is understood that all financial arrangements between the two departments would be negotiated individually.

It is also understood that the implementation of any agreement will commence upon its signing by both parties. The possibility and terms of renewal of any agreement will be discussed by the representatives of both departments within twelve months prior to its termination.
